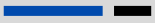

Our Process

Our main goal is to curate youth leaders under the age of 18. We believe that being doing so, college admissions becomes a byproduct rather than being a primary objective.

Our process of leadership curation splits into four main stages.

Stage 1: Diagnosis

This stage includes multiple examinations of personal qualities and personality traits, including strong skillsets and weaker skillsets. The goal behind diagnosis is to identify the future major and to understand more about the student's core abilities.

Stage 2: The Palm Tree

In this stage, we ask the student: What is one project you can work on for the next 2 years? How big can it grow, and how fast can it grow? What would be the best company to take an internship with? How can you grow tall, but be focused at the same time?

Stage 3: Personal Branding

In this stage, we connect the student's resume to build a larger narrative about their field of work and specialties. We also connect them with our partners in the media industry.

Stage 4: Essay Writing

We work with the student on bridging his personal experiences and personal brand to connect one unified, yet diverse personal brand, brought to life with propelling and creative writing.

Our Guarantee Policy

Although we believe that our program extends far beyond college admissions, we acknowledge that college admissions remains a core aspect of parents' desire to enroll their kids in EDAD. Hence, we follow a full guarantee policy, or 100% of the money back, in cash.

There are no terms other than the student attending more than 80% of the sessions, that they maintain their school grades, and work with us on the SAT by completing their assigned tasks.
